

# Department 820 – Photography

## Department Requirements

- Participation in this department is open to amateur photographers only.
- Photograph must have been taken between the start of last year's Fair and the start of the current Fair.
- All photography exhibits must be mounted on sturdy, plain white, undecorated poster board. Photographs should be attached to the poster board with rubber cement or photography glue. Photo corners are not to be used. Photo displays must not be matted or framed.
- Snapshots must include four (4) photographs per lot mounted on 11 x 14 inch board.
- Enlargements may be 5"x 7" or 8"x 10" with one photograph per lot number: 5" x 7" photos should be mounted on 7" x 11" or 8" X 10" board: 8" x10" photos mounted on 11" x 14" board. Only one enlargement per photo. Mount the photograph the enlargement was taken from on back of mounting board.
- Exhibits will be evaluated on composition, (35%); story telling ability (35%); technical quality (20%); and mounting (10%)
- **Exhibitors are limited to entering no more than a total of 15 photography exhibits.**
- The type and age of camera used, type of film, digital mega pixels, as applies, must be recorded on the back of the display.
- Suggestions for better quality photography exhibit:
  - All photos in an exhibit should be either color or black and white, or two and two
  - All photos in an exhibit should be of the same finish – matte or glossy, or two and two
