DEPARTMENT REQUIREMENTS:

- All produce exhibited must be from the current year's crop and are the result of the exhibitor's own work.
- Refer to UW Extension Publication A3306, <u>Exhibiting and Judging Vegetables</u> for guidelines on selecting, cleaning and trimming vegetables for exhibit. Garden vegetables are judged according to guidelines contained in Publication A3306. It can be viewed or purchased on-line at <u>http://learningstore.uwex.edu/pdf/A3306.pdf</u>.
- Fruits and vegetables need to be cleaned but not washed. Dirty or spoiled produce will be disqualified.
- The number of specimens to be exhibited is in parenthesis behind each lot description.

Class A – Vegetables - Premium Code D

- Exhibit may represent human, animal or inanimate objects automobile, airplane, tractor, robot, etc.
