

Department 715 - Flowers and House Plants

DEPARTMENT REQUIREMENTS:

- All exhibits must be the work of the exhibitor.
- See UW Extension Publication A2935, <u>Evaluating and Judging Flowers and Indoor Plants</u> for information on preparing and exhibiting flowers and houseplants. This publication can be viewed, printed, or purchased online at http://learningstore.uwex.edu/pdf/A3306.pdf.
- Collection and exhibition of plant specimens of state or federally protected, or endangered species are not allowed.
- Containers will be provided by the Fair unless otherwise noted.
- Houseplants must be grown from seeds; leaf, stem, sectional cuttings; or divisions since August of the preceding year.
- A wooden or plastic marker labeled with the species and the date started must be inserted into pot.
- Pots must weigh less than 20 lbs.

CLASS A - Flowers and Houseplants - Premium Code A

Cut Flowers, Bouquets, Arrangements

Lot Numbers:

- 1. Marigold, large, any color, single stem
- 2. Snapdragon 6 spikes one or more cultivars
- 3. Sunflower, small, fancy, single bloom
- 4. Zinnia bouquet, 5 or more small blooms
- 5. Zinnia bouquet, 4 or more large blooms
- 6. Petunia bouquet, 5 or more blooms
- 7. Any other Annual 6 stems one or more cultivar
- 8. Floral arrangement in your own container
- 9. Gladiolus, 1 stem

Potted Plants

Lot Numbers:

- 10. Cactus, desert type (potted in your container)
- 11. Philodendron (potted in your container)
- 12. Geranium (potted in your container)
- 13. Coleus (potted in your container)
