

Department 716 – Natural Science

DEPARTMENT REQUIREMENTS:

- Collections must be mounted on 11" x 16" sized stiff backing material such as cardboard, tag board, foam board, plywood, hardboard, or other material. Collection must be titled and dated.
- Specimens in collections and scrapbooks should be labeled with common and scientific name of specimen (where appropriate), where collected, and date of collection. This includes collections of photographs.
- Scrapbooks must be 8 ½" x 11" or 11" x 16".
- Collection of specimens of state or federally protected or endangered plant species, and bird nests are not allowed.
- Insects must be properly killed, mounted, labeled, and identified.
- Insect collection labels, in addition to insect name, must contain the following: Date of capture, Location, Name or initials of Collector.
- Insects should be identified at least to scientific order.

CLASS A – Natural Sciences – Premium Code A

Lot Numbers:

- 1. Collection of leaves from 15 different species of native Wisconsin trees, pressed, mounted, and labeled
- Scrapbook of leaf prints or rubbings from 15 species of Wisconsin trees, labeled. One print or rubbing per page
- 3. Home built wood duck nesting box
- 4. Scrapbook of 10 species of birds of Wisconsin. Include picture or photo and description of habitat, foods and life cycle
- 5. Styrofoam or cardboard easel (8 ½" x 11") displaying 3 homemade tied fishing flies and 1 homemade artificial bait. Tips of hooks on exhibit must be covered with Styrofoam, putty, or a drop of glue for safety.
- 6. Collection of 10 insects, mounted and correctly labeled
