REQUIREMENTS:

- Eligibility requirements for exhibitors in the open class cat show are outlined in the General Rules and General Rules & Regulations for Junior Open, Open, and Nursing Home Residents sections of the Oconto County Fair premium list.
- All health requirements must be met before the animals are entered. See Health Requirements Section of the fair premium list.
- Exhibitors must present documentation of current immunizations for distemper, rhinotracheitis, calici and rabies to the show superintendent at check in for all cats entered. Most recent immunization must be not less than 30 days prior to show date.
- Any cat displaying symptoms of any contagious disease or parasites will not be allowed to show.
- Purebreds, mixed breeds and household pets may be shown and will be shown together.
- No intact (non-neutered), adult male cats may be shown.
- Hair coat definitions:
 - O Long Hair: Hair coat more than 1" in length
 - o Short Hair: Hair coat 1" or less in length
- Kittens must be four months old by show date.
- Exhibitors may enter one cat per premium list item number.
- Cats brought to the Fair must be properly controlled. They must be collared/haltered and leashed or in a carrier.
- Cats will be evaluated on general appearance and condition, temperament and proper handling, hair coat, paws, nails and body build.
- Cats' toenails must be clipped.
- Cats or kittens exhibited in the Junior Class show may not be shown in the Open Class show.
- The Open Class cat show will be the Sunday preceding the Fair, beginning at 9:30 a.m.

- 1. Male kitten, short hair (4-8 months of age)
- 2. Male kitten, long hair (4-8 months of age)
- 3. Female kittens, short hair (4-8 months of age)
- 4. Female kittens, long hair (4-H months of age)
- 5. Unspayed female cats, short hair (adult cats over 8 months of age)
- 6. Unspayed female cats (adult cats over 8 months of age)
- 7. Spayed or neutered cats, short hair (over 8 months of age)
- 8. Spayed or neutered cats, long hair (over 8 months of age)
