CLASS A - Promoting Membership or Improving Awareness of Youth Organizations

Lot Numbers:

- 1. A poster designed to promote youth membership or improve club awareness
- 2. A written speech or outline to promote youth membership or improve club awareness
- 3. A display promoting membership or improving youth awareness. Attach 3 x 5 card to explain use
- 4. A 3 to 5 minute video to promote membership or improve youth awareness
- 5. A 3 to 5 minute Power Point presentation to promote membership or improve youth awareness.
- 6. A poster designed to teach a specific youth project
- 7. A display to teach a specific youth project with a 3 x 5 card explaining use
- 8. A written speech or outline teaching a specific youth project
- 9. A 3 to 5 minute video teaching a specific youth project skill
- 10. A written outline for at least 4 project meetings in a selected project or activity
- 11. A display or scrapbook used to plan, evaluate, or review a specific role you played as a youth leader
- 12. A 3 to 5 minute video used to plan or for evaluation on review of a specific role you played as a youth leader, editing allowed.
- 13. Any other item related to youth leadership not listed above.
